Featured speaker **Carlos Mauricio** was working as a professor at the University of El Salvador when he was abducted and taken to National Police Headquarters. There, Carlos was detained and tortured for nearly two weeks. He suspects that his torturers chose him because he had been outspoken against the government in El Salvador. Upon his release, Carlos fled to the United States. In 2002, Carlos testified about his repeated torture in a U.S. federal court in Florida. The jury found two retired Salvadoran generals responsible for torture, rape and other atrocities. Carlos is now dedicated to helping other survivors begin to tell their stories.



The expressive arts group **Owl & Panther** is coming from Tucson to join the event. The Owl & Panther group participates in creative writing, counseling, and community service programs. The children and teens come from families that have been affected by torture and trauma. Through their poetry, participants share feelings about their experiences and the challenges they face living in a new country.

The event will conclude with live music performers and a reception of wine and gourmet chocolate desserts.

Directions

From the North

- Use I-5 (South), exit at Sea World Drive and Tecolote Road (just past the Hilton Hotel on Mission Bay).
- Turn left on Tecolote Road.
- Turn right at Morena Blvd.
- Turn left on Napa Street to Linda Vista Road.
- Make a left at the first stoplight on Linda Vista Road onto Marian Way, USD's West Entrance.
- Institute garage is first right at top of hill.
- Take elevator to 1st Floor.

From the South and East:

- From the East: Use I-8 (West) and exit at Morena Blvd.
- From the South: Use I-5 (North) to I-8 (East) and exit at the first exit, Morena Blvd.
- Follow Morena Blvd, and bear right onto Linda Vista Road.
- Make a left at the second stoplight on Linda Vista Road onto Marian Way, USD's West Entrance.
- Institute garage is first right at top of hill.
- Take elevator to 1st Floor.
